

Post-Monsoon 2025 Rainfall

Highlights:

- During the year 2025, the country's rainfall was **near average** (-3%) observed.
- During post-monsoon season (OND) 2025, the country's rainfall was **below** average (19%), which was more or less similar over all provinces except Sindh received **largely above average** rainfall (+77%) during the period.
- During October 2025, the country's rainfall was **largely above average** with positive anomaly of (+53%). Similarly, Punjab with (+159), Sindh with (+123%) and AJK with (+56) observed Largely above average. In contrast, rainfall over Balochistan was **well below average** (-45%) and **near average** (-5%) over Gilgit-Baltistan.
- November 2025, country rainfall was largely below average with negative anomaly (-72%). Similarly, all the regions exhibited **largely below average** rainfall except Sindh with (+14), received **slightly above** average rainfall.
- In December 2025, the country's rainfall was **significantly below** average (-41%), which was more or less similar over all regions except Sindh which received **largely above average** rainfall (+48%).
