The new moon of **Safar 1447 AH** will born on crossing conjunction point at **00-11 PST** on **25-07-2025**. Astronomical parameters of new moon and average cloud amounts at Pilot Balloon Observatories of Pakistan Meteorological Department are attached herewith.

According to astronomical parameters, there is **No Chance** of sighting the new moon of **Safar 1447 AH** on the evening of **25-07-2025** (i.e on 29th Muharram 1447 AH).

According to climate record, the weather is expected to be partly cloudy/Cloudy in most parts of the country.
