The new moon of **Ziquad 1446 AH** will born on crossing conjunction point at **00-31 PST** on **28-04-2025**. Astronomical parameters of new moon and average cloud amounts at Pilot Balloon Observatories of Pakistan Meteorological Department are attached herewith.

According to astronomical parameters, there is **a Chance** of sighting the new moon of **Ziquad 1446 AH** on the evening of **28-04-2025** (i.e on 29th Shawwal 1446 AH).

According to climate record, the weather is expected to be partly cloudy/fair in most parts of the country.
